Phase I Activities

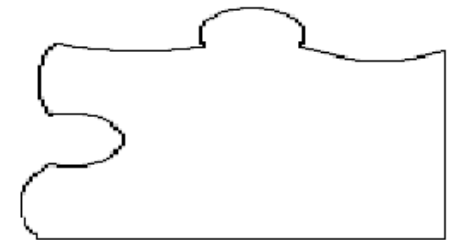
- Defining 'restraint'

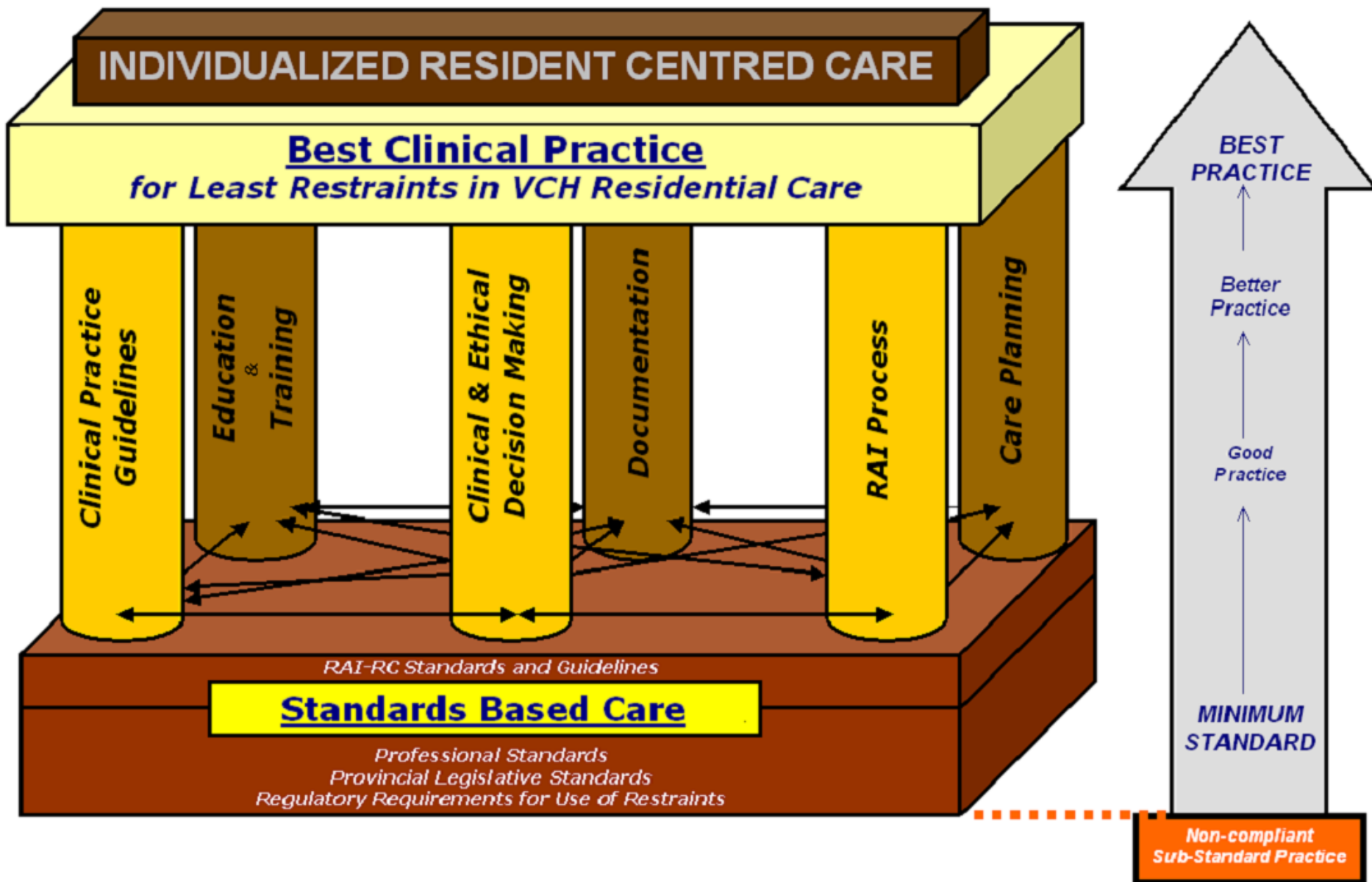
Phase II & III Activities

- Piloting of least restraint Clinical Practice Document



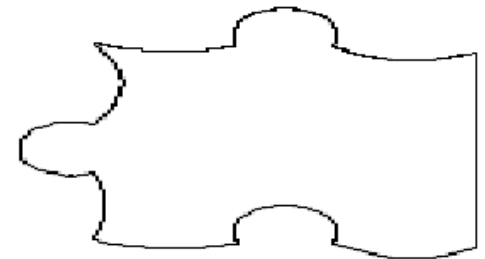
Puzzle Piece #4

Standards Based Care Framework



Knowledge Sharing & Integration

- Utilizing a person centered approach within the web of safety initiatives to influence best practice in residential care (i.e. falls, agitation, continence, delirium)
